

EDITAL**NOTICE OF OPENING OF COMPETITION PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION AND HIRING OF A PhD RESEARCHER, UNDER THE LEGAL REGIME OF SCIENTIFIC EMPLOYMENT**

Applications are open for one PhD researcher position - category of Junior Researcher, the career of scientific research for the project LOOKING AT CRIME: COMMUNITIES AND PHYSICAL SPACES, reference PTDC/DIR-DCP/28120/2017, regulated by Decree-Law no. 57/2016, of August 29, as changed by Law no. 57/2017, of July 19. The contract of indefinite duration is funded by grant PTDC/DIR-DCP/28120/2017.

The procedure can be applied for national, foreign and stateless doctorates who hold a scientific and professional curriculum that reveals a profile appropriate to the activity to be developed, considering:

1. PhD in Criminology or Psychology of Justice; 2. Ability to join and develop new projects in the group, in the areas of public safety and crime prevention. 3. Proficient in the Portuguese language.

If the doctorate has been awarded by a foreign higher education institution, it must comply with the provisions of Decree-Law no. 341/2007, of October 12, and any formalities established there must be fulfilled until the expiration date for the application.

1. Knowledge and practice of criminology, with emphasis on analysis of official statistics, analysis of self reported crime and in crime prevention through environmental design. 2. Experience in peer-reviewed publishing (Web of Science or Scopus). 3. Contributions to top-class research, including peer-reviewed publications. 4. Proficiency in the English language (scientific writing and good oral communication).

The candidate will join the research project LOOKING AT CRIME: COMMUNITIES AND PHYSICAL SPACES and will work at the University Fernando Pessoa location in Porto under the supervision of a researcher to be appointed. The tasks to be performed are related to the research activities of the project.

More specifically the candidate will be involved in tasks 1 "Computer application", 2 "Sample selection, and data collection" and 3 "Physical spaces observation".

To fulfill those tasks, and related ones, the candidate must have knowledge of systematic analysis, data gathering and analysis with SPSS, produce oral and written communications, and write scientific papers (in Portuguese and English). The candidate is also expected to collaborate in other scientific activities of the group and to actively contribute to the research excellence of the group.

Applicable law is Decree-Law no. 57/2016, of August 29, as changed by Law no. 57/2017, of July 19, that stimulates the creation of scientific and technological jobs in all knowledge areas (RJEC), by the Labour Code passed as Law no. 7/2009, of February 12, and other applicable laws and regulations.

The work is to be performed at University Fernando Pessoa location at Praça 9 de Abril, 349; 4249-004 Porto

There is 1 (one) position available, full time and on an exclusive dedication basis. In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 3 of Article 7 of Decree-Law no. 57/2016 of August 29, as amended by Law No. 57/2017, of July 19, implies the renunciation of the exercise of any function or remunerated activity, public or private, including the exercise of a liberal profession, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 4 of the same article. Hiring of the candidate is subject to the available budget under the

previous laws and the Science and Technology Foundation (FCT) regulations and procedures. The contract is expected to start in January 2019.

The net monthly salary is 2.128,34 EUROS (two thousand one hundred and twenty eight Euros and thirty four cents), in accordance with Decree Law No. 57 and subsequent legislation, corresponding to level 33 of the single remuneration table.

Pursuant Article 5, no. 57/2016 of August 29, as amended by Law No. 57/2017, of July 19, the selection of doctorates to be contracted is made through the evaluation of the its scientific and curricular path. The evaluation of the scientific and curricular course focuses on relevance, quality and timeliness:

- (a) the scientific, technological, cultural or artistic production of the last five years considered to be more relevant by the applicant;
- b) Applied or practice-based research activities developed over the last five years and considered as having the greatest impact on the candidate;
- c) The activities of extension and dissemination of knowledge developed during the last five years, in particular in the context of promoting the culture and scientific practices considered by the candidate to be of greater relevance;
- d) The activities of management of science, technology and innovation programs or of the experience in observing and monitoring the scientific and technological system or higher education, in Portugal or abroad.

The period of five years referred to in the preceding paragraph may be increased by the jury, at the request of the candidate, when justified on grounds of suspension of scientific activity for socially protected reasons, namely for reasons of parental leave, prolonged serious illness, and other situations of unavailability for work legally protected.

The bankruptcy procedure is governed by non-discrimination and equal access.

The selection and classification of the candidates will be done through the analysis of the documents and individual interview (in Portuguese), with the three candidates with the best rankings. Candidates will be classified based on the following criteria: A- Scientific and curricular 90% and Interview 10%.

The assessment of the CV of the candidates, in particular scientific merit and research capacity, shall be made according to the following criteria:

a) Detailed CV:

- List of scientific publications and their impact factor (25%)
- Research projects in which they participate (15%)
- Experience in research relevant to the area in which they apply (30%)

b) Letter of motivation:

- Interest and motivation for the research area where the profiles to be contracted (15%)
- Proficiency in English and written communication (5%)

c) Interview (10%)

The final classification system for candidates is expressed on a scale of 0 to 20.

The jury deliberates by means of nominal votes based on the selection criteria adopted and published, and abstentions are not allowed.

Minutes of the jury meetings are drawn up, which contain a summary of what has taken place in them, as well as the votes cast by each of the members and their reasons, being offered to the candidates whenever requested.

After completing the application of the selection criteria, the jury prepares the ordered list of successful candidates with their classification.

Panel's final decision shall be validated by the leader of the institution, who is also in charge of deciding about the hiring.

If none of the candidates has the required profile, no candidate will be selected.

Applications are open from the 28th November to the 11th December 2018.

Optionally, the candidates may include documents that they consider relevant for the evaluation of the candidacy.
