Declaration of commitment to comply with the general conditions of attendance

I, _____ (full name), bearer of Citizen Card or legal equivalent (Passport or Identity Card) no. _____ issued by _____ (country), declare, under oath and for the purposes of application and admission, that I comply with the provisions of Article 26 of the Regulations for access and admission to the Integrated Masters in Medicine of the School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences of the University Fernando Pessoa*.

*Article 26

General attendance conditions

- Teaching of the integrated master's degree in medicine is bilingual - predominantly in English in the first cycle of studies (180 ECTS); predominantly in Portuguese in the second cycle of studies (180 ECTS), therefore proper command of the English language is indispensable for attendance of the entire cycle of studies, with fluency in the Portuguese language also being mandatory for the clinical rotations that take place from the fourth to the sixth years of the course.
- The general attendance conditions are:
 - Oral and written English language proficiency of at least level C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages;
 - At the time of admission to the study cycle: competence in Portuguese language of at least level A2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages;
 - In order to attend the 4th curricular year and above: competence in Portuguese language of at least level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.
- Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 5, level C1 oral and written proficiency in English must be proven at the time of applying, by presenting one of the following documents:
 - Documentary evidence that English is the applicant's native or habitual language of communication or that the applicant has received their schooling in English;
 - Certificates of approval in Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE) or Cambridge English: Proficiency (CPE), the latter with a qualification equal to or higher than Very Good (≥ 160 points);
 - International English Language Testing System (IELTS - Academic) certificate, with a minimum score of 7;
 - Certificate of the Test of English as a Foreign Language, Internet -Based Test (TOELF iBT), with a minimum score of 85.
- Notwithstanding the provisions of the following number, level A2 knowledge of the Portuguese language must be proven at the time of application, by means of LPE certification issued by a centre for the evaluation of Portuguese as a foreign language.
- Students who, at the time of their application, do not have proof of proficiency in English and/or knowledge of the Portuguese language, under the terms of the previous numbers, may submit themselves to a written and oral assessment exam at level C1 and level A2, respectively, to be held at the Faculty of Human and Social Sciences of UFP.





6. In cases where knowledge of the Portuguese language is below B2 level, and in order to comply with the provisions of number 1, non-Portuguese-speaking students are required to attend Portuguese Language for Foreigners (PLF) classes at the Faculty of Human and Social Sciences at UFP. Their knowledge will be gauged through a formative assessment of communication skills at the end of the 2nd year and confirmed through summative assessment at the end of the 3rd year. Students must have passed this assessment in order to attend the training stage and the clinical rotations.
